August 19th and 20th, 2017 will be the third annual pilot friendly war bird event hosted by Love Air Radio Control Club at the Drake Field, 10 miles east of Ft. Collins, CO just off State Highway 14.

This is a no-pressure, fly all you want to event for pilots featuring war bird airplanes of all sizes. This is an AMA sanctioned event and pilots must be AMA members to fly. The event fee is \$20.00 and runs from 9:00am – 5:00pm Saturday, August 19th and from 9:00 am to noon Sunday, August 20th. Unrestricted flying is open before and after these hours so pack along a few aerobatic planes in addition to the war birds.

Trophies for best war bird in four categories (vintage/WWI era, WWII era, modern era and best of show) will be awarded Saturday afternoon. In addition, a hot lunch will be served Saturday for \$7.00 per plate.

Participants the last two years have enjoyed excellent weather conditions and great fun flying in formation with their buddies or dropping bombs and showing off their piloting skills.

Camping at the site is welcome and helps to encourage meeting fellow pilots and making new friends.
